**A SUBMISSION TO THE NEW SOUTH WALES SUPREME COURT BY
LOSALINI RAINIMA DATED FRIDAY 18TH APRIL, 2008.**

Your Honour,

Re: My unlawful imprisonment.

I am a free woman created by God and I have certain inalienable rights.

A right is something which is good, correct and true. To do right is to do something which is good, correct and true.

The words on the Royal Coat of Arms say, "God and my right" and "Evil be to him who evil thinks". And the words of the Judicial Oath are that a Judicial officer will "do right".

To deny what is right is wrong.

Trial by jury is a right. It is something which is right because the Holy Bible says, in Matthew 7:1 and Luke 6:37, "Do not judge" and only with the congregation of 12 of my equals, who are gathered in God's name (Matthew 18:20) by asking "So help me God", can a judgment be delivered from the unanimity of their consciences as to whether I have done wrong, ie: that I am guilty, and impose any punishment.

The court, which judged that I had done wrong and imprisoned me, was not “a place where justice is administered” because justice is “the protection of rights and the punishment of wrongs”.

That court had no jurisdiction to proceed summarily because I never, at any stage, gave my consent to be without a jury.

I have been denied my right to trial by jury.

I have been wrongly imprisoned.

I must be set free, immediately.
